- Improve family outcomes by strengthening existing 2-Gen programs and services.

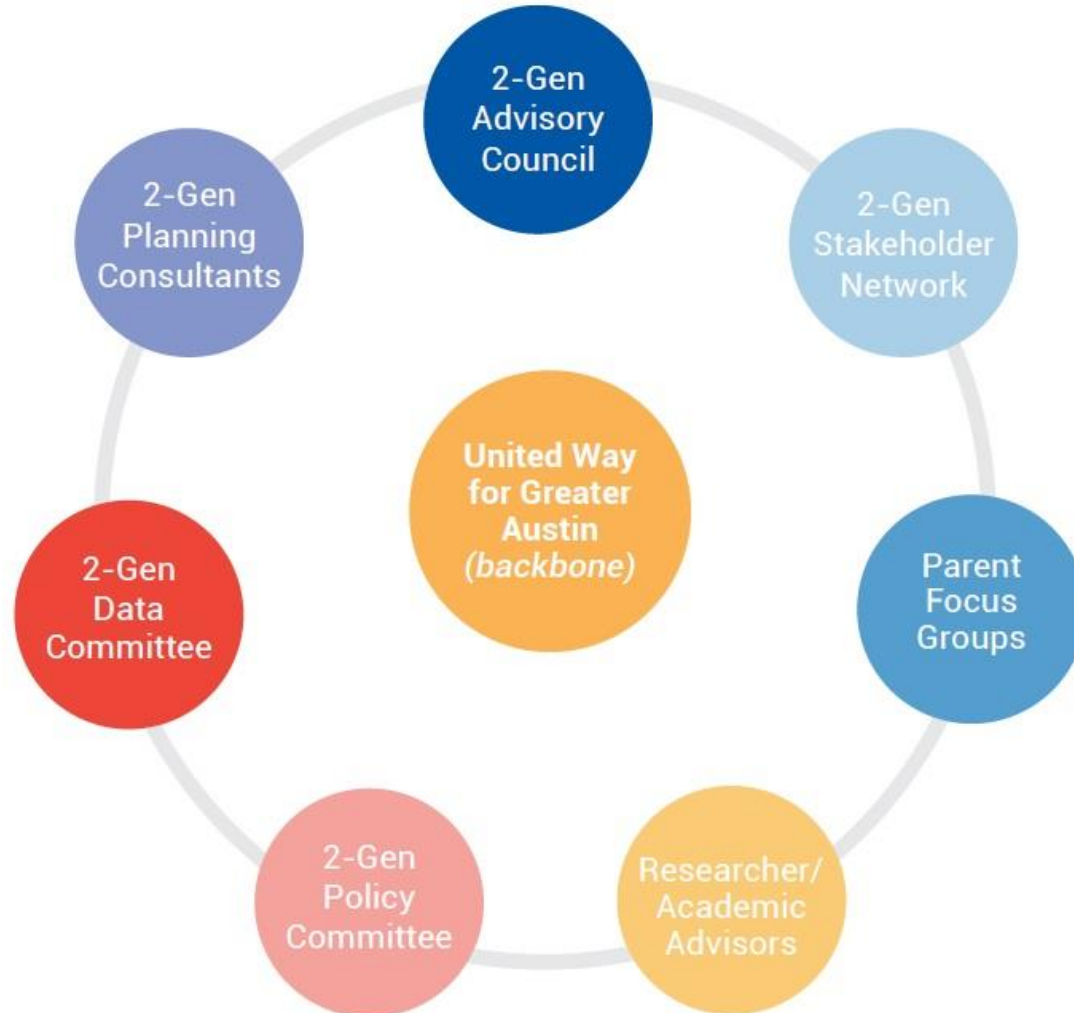
