## **Top Priority 2020 Family Pathways Strategies and Action Steps**

## **Overarching Systems Change**

- 1.3 Cultivate strategic partnerships between adult-serving and child-serving institutions that administer large-scale services.
  - 1.3.A Convene major organizations that primarily serve adults with organizations that primarily serve children to identify ways to better utilize existing community resources and serve whole families on a large scale. (e.g., ISDs, ACC, Head Start)
- 1.7 Support the capacity of service providers who currently serve families using a 2-Gen approach.
  - 1.7.A Provide funding to organizations in the 2-Gen network to expand capacity to serve families using a 2-Gen approach.
  - 1.7.D Provide support and assistance with collecting and utilizing data to demonstrate positive outcomes for children and families

## **Educational Success**

- 2.1 Co-locate educational offerings for children and parents/ caregivers.
  - 2.1.A Support partners interested and ready to co-locate to provide 2-Gen approaches, via technical assistance and helpful resources
  - 2.1.B Work with funders to create new funding for childcare offered concurrent with part time training for parents
- 2.4 Make it easier for families served through a 2-Gen approach to access subsidized childcare.
  - 2.4.A Simplify childcare subsidy enrollment process for parents/caregivers
- 2.5 Improve access to adult education and training by reducing financial and logistical barriers to participation.
  - 2.5.A Support parents/caregivers who want to return to school to pay back education debt so they can enroll (e.g., establish debt relief program for ACC students)
- 2.8 Increase enrollment in and completion of programs leading to middle-skill jobs for parents/ caregivers served through a 2-Gen approach, prioritizing programs in healthcare, IT, and trades.
  - 2.8.A Implement ongoing process (e.g., quarterly trainings, communications) to ensure service providers are knowledgeable about education and job training leading to middle-skill jobs
  - 2.8.B Support family serving organizations to increase parent enrollment and completion in education and middle skill job training and begin tracking this

- 5.2 Increase the availability of financial products and resources that can be used by families served through a 2-Gen or Near 2-Gen approach to fulfill their financial goals (by engaging the business community, financial institutions, and/or community agencies)
