2016 At A Glance

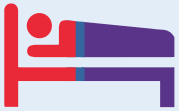
In 2016, we provided **9,978 clients** with **143,228 hours** of service. All of our programs are offered in Spanish and in English.

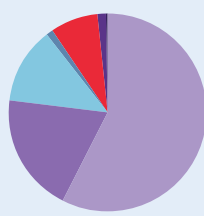

RESIDENTIAL DEMOGRAPHICS

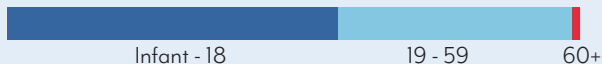

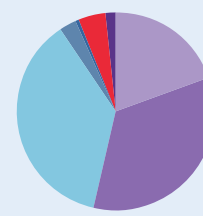


NON-RESIDENTIAL COUNSELING DEMOGRAPHICS
