ALTERNATIVES TO INCARCERATION



EMPOWERING PEOPLE FOR BRIGHTER FUTURES

Trinity Alliance was founded in 1912 and is a 501C3 not-for-profit organization.

RE-ENTRY

We assist youth, ages 16-20, who currently reside in the Albany County Jail through assessment, crisis intervention, referral for critical service needs and post release planning. The core of this program features a 12-session series of workshops that focus on a new way of thinking, problem solving and daily living skills, job readiness, and special presentations from key resources of the community.

HOMER PERKINS CENTER ALCOHOL AND SUBSTANCE REHABILITATION

We work under a philosophy that understands that chemical dependence is a bio-psycho-social disease that can never be cured, but can be forced into remission, if the chemically or alcohol dependent person is helped to achieve total abstinence from substance and/or alcohol abuse.

Our 20 bed, 12-month intensive holistic residential center for men 18+ years of age, is available to NYS residents who are seeking treatment for substance and alcohol abuse. We also provide a continuum of treatment services and counseling for families of the person seeking this life-changing treatment.



Individual counseling is also provided as part of the post release plan. Intensive support, guidance, encouragement and advocacy from staff represent a vital piece for our participants as they re-enter the community to begin a new chapter of their lives - as stronger, more empowered, responsible individuals.

SHARP (Trinity's Settlement House Advocacy and Resource Program) is a program of Re-Entry. We provide short and long term assistance in the form of case management, referrals, advocacy in the attainment of services, housing, health care, and employment services. We offer assistance with day-to-day issues, address barriers, help with job readiness, resume preparation and employment retention, based on what our client's needs are. We help move our clients into a stable, positive life situation.

VIOLENCE PREVENTION AND INTERVENTION

Albany Cure Violence and Leaders Leading Troy's Youth are two violence prevention and intervention programs, based in Albany and Troy. We treat violence as a "disease" that is spread by infectors, and we work to engage those at the physical and social epicenter of violence, by redirecting them into more productive lifestyles, preventing retaliation.

Our outreach workers lead by example and earn the trust of our participants by showing them that a violence-free lifestyle is desirable.



SUPPORTIVE

We address the housing needs of those who are homeless, or at risk of becoming homeless by providing affordable housing with support and promoting healthy families through case management. Our housing clients can receive all of Trinity's wrap around services, as part of their transition into independent living.
