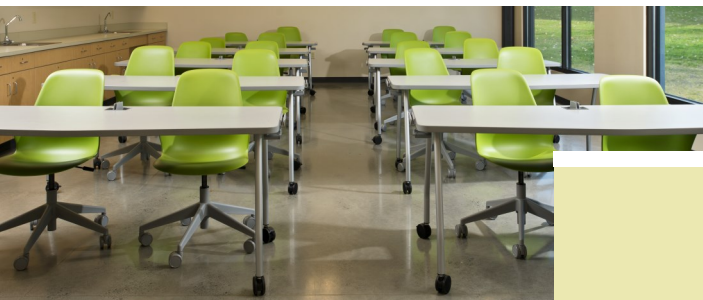

## FOOD PANTRIES

Trinity’s Food Pantries are meant for those in dire situations - a lost job, victims of fire, and/or a family that lost their food stamps - no local individual or family is turned away, and all you need to apply for assistance is an ID Card and proof of address. Those in need will receive an assortment of food goods including milk, cheese, eggs, butter, canned goods, proteins, breads and fresh produce. Those we serve also receive recipes to make healthy meals with these ingredients. Other household items such as kitchen supplies, hygiene products, diapers and formula are also available.

## CARE AFTER SCHOOL AND SUMMER CAMP

More than 120 children, ages 5-12, are given the opportunity to come to a safe, nurturing environment, receive homework assistance, a healthy snack, and participate in activities that leads to happier, healthier children and families. Children in our Summer Camp enjoy friendships and educational field trips during the summer months between school semesters.
