







# THE FACTS

THE GLOBAL SLAVERY INDEX 2016 INDICATES THERE ARE AT LEAST **46 MILLION SLAVES** IN THE WORLD TODAY: WOMEN, CHILDREN, AND MEN HELD BY FORCE UNABLE TO WALK AWAY, DOING THINGS THEY DON'T WANT TO DO.

SLAVERY IS KNOWN TO OCCUR IN **167 COUNTRIES** AROUND THE WORLD. **58%** OF THE WORLD'S SLAVES LIVE IN **INDIA**, **CHINA**, **PAKISTAN**, **BANGLADESH**, AND **UZBEKISTAN** 

SLAVERY TAKES **MANY FORMS,** INCLUDING FORCED OR BONDED LABOR, SEX TRAFFICKING, FORCED MARRIAGE, COMMERCIAL SEXUAL EXPLOITATION OF CHILDREN, AND MORE.

THERE ARE **MORE SLAVES IN THE U.S. TODAY** THAN AT THE TIME OF THE CIVIL WAR. AN ESTIMATED **300,000 DOMESTIC MINORS** ARE SEX SLAVES IN THE U.S.

- > by teaching 10,000+ students from middle school to college level about human trafficking and modern slavery
- > by training key influencers of society on how to identify abuse and combat exploitation in their community
- by hosting events like

- > by partnering with missionaries, nationals, and agencies to protect children from commercial sexual exploitation in Europe and Southeast Asia
- > by supporting improvements the foster care system in the U.S.
- > by teaching **youth** around the world how to protect themselves

- > by partnering with outreach ministries
- > by providing spiritual, emotional, physical, relational, and mental support to those caught in slavery and the cycle of abuse to help them exit their bondage
- > by helping shift the cultural values that validate slavery to bring holistic freedom to communities

- > by planting missions to promote racial reconciliation and address brokenness in urban areas in the U.S.
- > by supporting Eden's Glory, a **restoration home** in Illinois for female survivors of human trafficking
- > by partnering with social enterprises and to create livelihood opportunities

- > we support 40+ leaders in the U.S. and around the world to heal brokenness in their communities
- > we partner strong with 100+ groups at the local, national, and global level to maximize our impact
- > we mobilize all aspects of society: faith, family, business, academia, law media, culture, and health care

Our philosophy is that **local leadership** knows best. That's why we come alongside to coach, support, and raise up leaders in North America and around the world in ways that make sense for that context.










# OUR GROWTH
