

OKC COMMUNITY SENTENCING

HOW IT WORKS



ELIGIBILITY:

- Defendant in need of treatment/ case management services
- Common Offenses
 - Property
 - Moderate risk alcohol-related
 - Moderate risk drug-related
 - Apps to accelerate/ revoke (non-compliance to ongoing treatment needs)
- LSI-R Score 19-54 or any score (1-54) on LSI-R with significant mental health issues
- Criminogenic needs identified through Ohio Risk Assessment System (ORAS)

UPON SENTENCING:

1. Client reports to supervision (case manager) within 72 hours of sentencing
2. Case manager reviews LSI-R or ORAS to make referrals to treatment providers based on identified needs
3. Treatment providers notify case manager of treatment violations
4. Intermediate sanctions for non-compliance include:
 - Increased treatment, increased supervision, community service, and/or jail time
5. Exit: Successful completion or revocation

TREATMENT SERVICES:

- Substance Abuse Treatment and Mental Health Care:
 - Assessments
 - Outpatient
 - Inpatient
 - Female Opportunity Group
 - Cognitive/ Behavioral
 - Anger Management
 - Life/ Job Skills
- Access to over 25 mental health care and substance abuse treatment providers
- Employment Assistance
