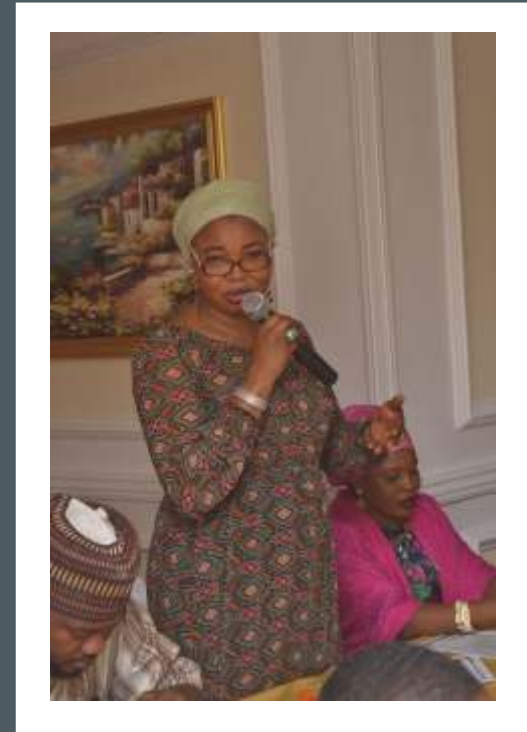
FORWARD

The Girls Aint Cheap (GAC) talktable was unveiled. EL-MHSF along with other stakeholders were in attendance to support the initiative, July 2017.

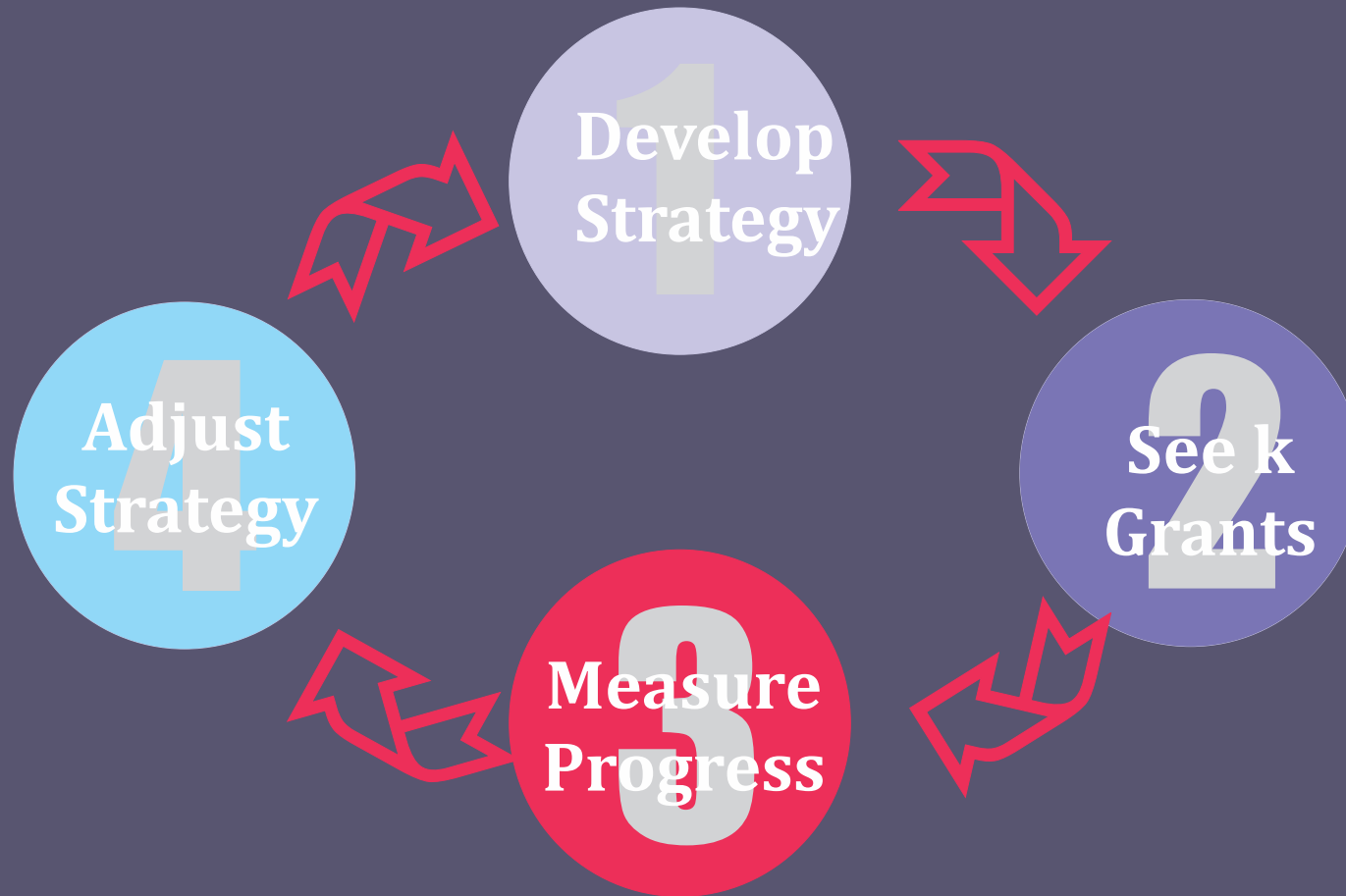
