Good Grief Gives Children a Voice

Good Grief of Northwest Ohio offers a safe, healing place to gather, grieve, receive, and share support.

- Group sessions provide children with a warm and welcoming place to process their grief and learn new coping skills.
- Professional staff and trained facilitators
 encourage young people (ages 4 to 24) to
 express their thoughts and feelings through
 music, play, art, and other activities.
- Parent/caregiver sessions are offered while kids' groups are in session, giving them an opportunity to share their grief and to learn ways to help their children.

There is never a charge for our services, and families can attend sessions for as long as they feel it is necessary.

- pre-screening interviews
- comprehensive 18-hour training
