Addition of a third course for Crafts Making which will give a chance to parents who requested earlier to RSNF-office to add this particular course for their children (we hope Accomplish Trust board of trustees will consider this request this time round

We shall continue community engagement activities to bring members on board. We will do this through sensitizing them and making them aware of the entire essence of the project, in order to work hand in hand with them.

We continue to appreciate the support and the efforts you have put in supporting us here in Uganda and pray that God continues to use you and all of us as we make a difference among the children with disability now and in future. God bless you all.
