McCap was founded in 2001 by a group of parents looking for alternative programming for their young adults who had recently graduated from high school. These young graduates with profound mental and physical challenges needed a place to continue their growth and development. McCap began as a summer program and has expanded in to a part time, year round day program.

McCap is a parent run organization and receives no state or federal funds. We operate solely through tuition, donations, fundraising and grants.

### Program Description

McCap is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit organization that serves young adults and their families with special needs in McHenry County and the surrounding areas.

Participants may choose a 2 or 3 day a week program. Monday,

Wednesday and Thursday 9:00 am to 3:00 pm are the days we are in session. We provide a 2:1 student to staff ratio and each participant is encouraged to reach their full potential.
