Within the cities of Glendale and El Mirage clients are referred by AAA (Area Agency on Aging), SAIL (Senior Adult Independent Living), or ALTCS (Arizona Long Term Care Health Services) program. Meals on Wheels clients receive a hot meal five days a week, Monday through Friday, with weekend frozen meals available with a referral from a Case Manager. Dietician approved menus are included in a monthly newsletter. Private meal deliveries are available.

Types of Services Provided:

- Dry or canned pet food provided
- Assist with community resources for spaying/neutering, vaccines, and licensing

Who is Eligible:

• The pet food is provided to low-income seniors and disabled persons who participate in the YWCA's Senior Programs.

Benefits of the Program:

- Pets are a vital source of companionship and love for many homebound seniors and those with disabilities.
- A study published by the Journal of the American Geriatrics Society demonstrated that independently living seniors who have pets tend to have better physical health and mental wellbeing.
- Seniors with pets are also more likely to be active, cope with stress better, and have better overall health than their counterparts.
